

FREQUENCY ADVERBS

They answer the question *How often.....?*

A. - EVERY {day, month, year}

ONCE/TWICE/3 TIMES {a week, a day...}

POSITION:

at the beginning or at the end of a sentence

**B. - USUALLY - NORMALLY - OFTEN - FREQUENTLY - SOMETIMES
OCCASIONALLY**

POSITION: at the beginning or mid position.

It consists of:

BE + adverb	<i>The weather is often bad</i>
Adverb + VERB	<i>We usually go to Madrid</i>
AUX + adverb + VERB *	<i>He can sometimes come</i>

* when there're two or more auxiliaries, adverbs are placed after the first one (*He would never have gone with you*)

C. - ALWAYS - NEVER - EVER - SELDOM = RARELY - HARDLY EVER

POSITION: mid position (but *always and never* can be placed at the beginning with imperative verbs)

Never ask her about her family.

Always look in your mirror before starting to drive.
