Harajuku Station in Tokyo is the centre of Japanese teenage culture. In the Harajuku area, there are many popular shops and fashion boutiques, but they aren't the main attraction. The main attraction is the teenagers! Japanese teenagers go to Harajuku Station on Sundays to hang out with their friends and to show everyone their unusual clothes. Thousands of visitors go to Harajuku Station every Sunday to see these teenagers and many photographers come to take their pictures for fashion magazines. Some teenagers look like Japan's favourite cartoon or video characters. Others dress like punk musicians. Many of the Harajuku girls look like children from 100 years ago. They wear dresses or short skirts with tights and they look like dolls. They call this the Lolita look. The Lolita look is very popular with Japanese teenagers. Some Lolitas have got long curly hair and they carry pretty handbags and umbrellas. Other Lolitas wear black and white clothes. They are the Gothic Lolitas. Their style is similar to the famous Camden Town fashions. There is one main difference. Gothic Lolitas prefer to use only a little make-up. They don't wear a lot of black make-up like the Camden Town teenagers. In both Camden Town and Harajuku, young people walk up and down the streets showing everyone some really amazing teenage fashions.
